What's different for 6th graders at Riverbend?

MANY THINGS ARE DIFFERENT FROM 5TH GRADE.

Here's some examples:

### At Riverbend Middle School:

- Subject oriented classes (English, Math, PE)
- Modern Computer Lab
- Huge library, with reading area and computers
- Student support services; attendance, counseling, nurse, psychologist, assistant principals and principal
- Lunch activities: basketball, volleyball courts, tetherball, soccer, softball and football fields.
- A cafeteria with many choices of food.
- Monthly assemblies for character building and academic honor roll.
- After school athletics(6<sup>th</sup> graders can do track and wrestling)
- You will have more responsibilities.
- You will be the youngest as opposed to being the oldest right now.

#### **Daily Schedule**

- School starts at 8:30 am and ends at 2:55 pm.
- 6<sup>th</sup> graders have a 6 period day (including lunch)two block/core periods and three individual periods, with 2 teachers.

Period 2: 9:29- 10:21
Break: 10:21- 10:31
Period 3: 10:34-11:28
Lunch: 11:28-12:03
Period 4: 12:06-1:00
Period 5: 1:03-1:56
Period 6: 1:59-2:55
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- Class placement is based on <u>your individual</u> performance.
- Band/Orchestra and Choir are offered during your AVID lite/AVID/PE classes

#### Sample 6<sup>th</sup> grade schedule

- Period 1: ELA
- Period 2: Soc. Studies
- Period 3: Math
- Lunch
- Period 4:Science
- Period 5: PE
- Period 6: Elective
- \*Band, Orch, Choir, AVID, Avid lite and Read 180 are Elective classes.
- Students in ELD will not have elective choices
- RSP services will be provided

### Middle School Grading in YCUSD and Riverbend

- You've moved from a standard's based reporting system (1's, 2's, 3's, 4's) to letter grades (Ā, B, C, D, F)
- You receive a separate grade for every class.
- You have 2 semesters; one in the fall, and one in the spring.
- Each semester you receive grades for the:
  - l<sup>st</sup> progress report
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> progress report
  - Semester Final Grade
- Your grades are mailed home
- Honor Roll students are recognized

## Tips for Success in 6<sup>th</sup> Grade.

- Have a strong backpack
- Keep an organized binder
- Take notes in all classes(except PE)
- Use your Agenda Daily
- Bring your materials(pencils, binder, highlighters) to school daily.
- Complete your work <u>EVERY</u> Day <u>AND</u> turn it in!
- Study for your tests ahead of time; Don't wait until the last minute.
- Communicate and get help from your teachers
- Follow school rules; don't give in to peer pressure
- Avoid Drama
- Report Bullies and Bullying(Stop the Silence)

- Eat a healthy breakfast.
- Complete and turn in all homework.
- Get to know your counselor
