Dear Yuba City Unified Families:

On Tuesday, January 12, 2021, the Yuba City Unified Governing Board took action and approved the return to the AM/PM Hybrid In-Person Learning Model for all preschool through 5th grade students, beginning January 19, 2021. If you did not complete the Return to School Survey indicating your preference for In-Person Learning or Distance Learning you can visit our website to fill it out, [click here to view the surveys](#). Your child's school will be contacting you this week if you have not completed the survey. If you have further questions, please reach out to your child's school.

In order to practice health and safety protocols and maintain six (6) feet between students, transportation will only be provided to students with disabilities who have transportation services identified in their Individualized Education Program (IEP). Students will be required to have their temperature taken before entering the bus to ensure that they do not have a fever of 100.4 or higher, must wear a facial covering while on the bus, and use hand sanitizer before boarding and disembarking from the bus.

Finally, all students in grades preschool through 5th are required to wear a facial covering when attending school, on the bus, and for all school functions. Your child is encouraged to bring their own facial covering but one will be provided if they arrive at school without one. If your child has a medical condition or disability that impacts their ability to wear a facial covering, a note from their primary medical provider will be required to determine if they meet the requirements for an exemption.
